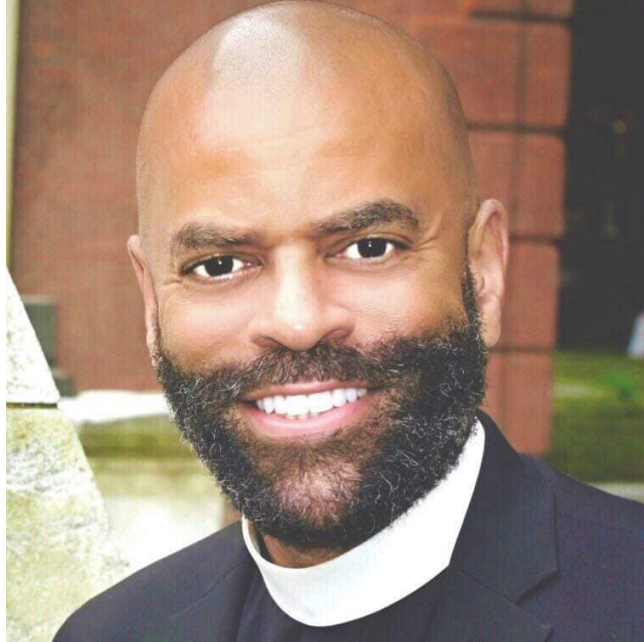

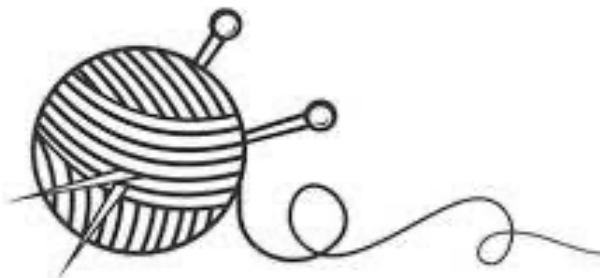

Annual Faithful Giving
