HISTORY OF THE LINKS, INCORPORATED THE PHILADELPHIA CHAPTER

On November 9, 1946, Margaret Rosell Hawkins and Sarah Strickland Scott, two young Philadelphia matrons invited seven of their friends to join them in organizing a new type of inter-city club. These two women envisioned an organization that would respond to the needs and aspirations of Black women in ways that existing clubs did not. It was their intent that the club would have a three fold aim - civic, educational, and cultural. Based on these aims, the club would implement programs, which it's founders hoped would foster cultural appreciation through the arts: develop richer inter-city group relations: and help women who participated to understand and accept their social and civic responsibilities.


Through exceptional program and services, the Philadelphia Chapter is proud to be in the forefront of civic outreach in the Philadelphia region.




